You are requested kindly to arrange the inspection of the aforesaid College/Institute in terms of Ordinance-XVI of K.U. Calendar, Volume-1, 2009 and as per norms laid down by the AICTE/State Govt./Kurukshetra University and submit the Inspection Report to this office on the enclosed revised prescribed proforma(s) for each course separately within 15 days positively since the extension in provisional affiliation is to be conveyed immediately.

You are also requested to submit the following documents after collecting from the college/institute:

1. Each case must be minutely scrutinized by Inspection Committee at its own level to ensure that the applicant institutions have requisite infrastructure in terms of lecture, theaters, laboratories, workshops, library, administrative block etc. and also qualified and experienced faculty ;
2. The institute/college should also fulfil all other norms required to run these courses. Past performance of such private technical education institutes should also be taken into account;
3. Course wise profile of the teaching staff in the enclosed proforma;
4. Statement of the accounts of the institution duly audited annually by a certified Chartered Accountant;
5. Statement of pay scales paid to the Director/Principal and the teaching and other staff as per the norms prescribed by the Council from time to time;
6. Certificate that the website information continuously being updated as and when changes take place; and
7. Two photograph of the inspection committee with the teaching and non teaching staff of the college/institute duly mentioning their names and designation;
8. You are also requested to verify the conditions (as already informed to the Institute) imposed by the previous Inspection Committee for the purpose of extension in provisional affiliation /additional course/increase intake.

It has been decided that the inspection be entirely recorded on video. Hence, at the time of the visit of the inspection Committee to the site, the college/institution concerned shall arrange the inspection to be video graphed in a manner that all important infrastructural and instructional facilities are video graphed along with interaction of the inspection Committee with the management, the teaching and the non-teaching staff. **The video-graphic of the inspection in CD form shall be submitted by the Inspection Committee along with its report on the prescribed Inspection proforma with the specific recommendations/observations/conditions required, if any.**
